1. Installation instructions for Magento 2.3

Extract the **.zip** file at the root of the Magento installation.

To install and activate the module you must run the following commands:

- `php bin/magento module:enable Toogas_easypay`
- `php bin/magento setup:upgrade`
- `php bin/magento setup:di:compile`
- `php bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy`

2. Installation of the update for magento 2.3

The upgrade process is the same as the installation process. However, before extracting the contents of the new installation zip you have to remove the previous module.

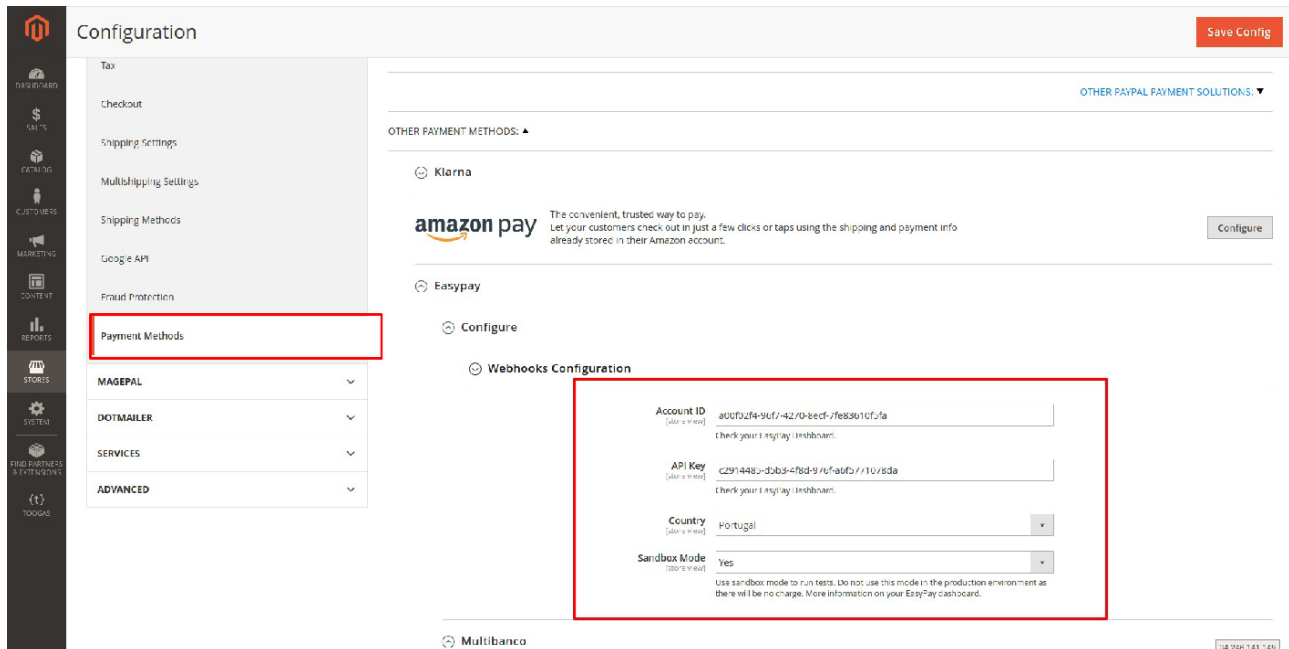
General

After logging in to Magento's Backoffice, you must access the easypay payment methods and make the general settings:


